There are over 38 million empty seats on the UK's roads every weekday, so by registering with Shared Wheels and sharing some of your car journeys you will be helping to make our roads cleaner, safer and traffic free.



Lancashire has its very own car-sharing website, part of the liftshare group Shared Wheels. Members register the journey they wish to share as a passenger, driver or both



and the website puts them in touch with other people going the same way. The fuel and parking costs of the journey are then shared by all travellers.

Free to register online and you would be expected to share the cost of fuel.
